On June 26, 2014 I requested that we talk about the problems between us. The mediation you requested didn't go anywhere. I was very willing to try it but needed transparency. I think it would be good for you and I to talk in person. I hope you do too. If you do, please contact me with available meeting times.

As I mentioned to you I believe you treat me unfairly. Another example of this is that you artificially limited the number of people serving on the curriculum committee to 5 although the dept policy and procedures state that "there shall be at least five departmental members chosen by the members of the department." I want to serve on the committee as well, especially since we finally have such a committee due to my efforts. As of right now members of the committee include only probationary faculty, with two being new hires, and one is a staff member. There are no tenured faculty members on the committee. As a tenured senior faculty member I request to be part of the team. I spoke with Dean Weber today and he said that there should be tenured faculty on the department curriculum committee. I think both Cheryl and Tom should serve as well.
