Dear Liz and Jeanne,

During our meeting today, August 16, 2013 at 10:00 AM, two options were presented to me by Dean Throop:

1. Resign with the option to collect unemployment insurance.
2. If I did not resign by 1:30 PM today, a termination recommendation would be sent to the Chancellor, and the university would contest my ability to draw unemployment insurance.

I have chosen to "resign" - as long as it is completely agreed upon that my "contract ended and was not renewed" as Dean Throop stated, so that I will be able to collect unemployment insurance, and so that my employment record will remain unblemished. This is the exact agreement.

I expect to collect the full payment for my internship supervision over the summer. If you would like me to do this before Monday, I can spend Sunday afternoon doing it. Not all of the students have completed internships on schedule, that is not my fault, I have supervised them throughout the summer as I was instructed to do.
