**ATTORNEY'S RESPONSE TO ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

Attorney Kimberly Penix hereby files her response to this Court's August 5, 2016, Order to Show Cause (ECF No. 9) for failure to respond to this Court's order of August 4, 2016, and respectfully states as follows:

1. Undersigned counsel unintentionally omitted required information in her original docketing statement filed on August 4, 2016, due to her limited experience with this honorable Court. (ECF No. 6). This Court ordered her to correct this omission by order dated August 4, 2016. (ECF No. 7).
2. The error compounded when the amended docketing statement remedied only half the deficiency pointed out by the Court's order. (ECF No. 8). This imprudent blunder resulted from relying on the order's docketing description when checking the draft amended docketing statement for compliance with the August 4, 2016, order, rather than relying on the full text of the order itself.
3. Attorney Penix has the upmost respect for this court and its operating procedures. Undersigned counsel apologizes to this Court as well as all parties-

in-interest and their counsel for these errors, which were regrettable, unintentional, and not the product of bad faith. Attorney Penix has re-reviewed the applicable Circuit Rules in an effort to prevent further errors.

4. Attorney Penix concurrently files a second amended docketing statement, which provides all the information required under the rules and this Court's order dated August 4, 2016.
5. Undersigned counsel understands the gravity of her errors, and will take all steps necessary to ensure that this type of oversight does not occur again.
