ORDER

Circuit Rule 3(c)(1), referencing Circuit Rule 28(a), requires an appellant to file a docketing statement which identifies the “provision of the constitution” or “federal statute” involved if, as appellant claims, jurisdiction is based on the existence of a federal question pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1331.

In the present case, appellant's Circuit Rule 3(c) docketing statement fails to set forth the federal statute or constitutional provision involved in this case. Appellant must provide this information.

Also, Circuit Rule 3(c)(1), referencing Circuit Rule 28(a), requires an appellant to file a docketing statement which provides information concerning appellate jurisdiction.

In the present case, appellant's Circuit Rule 3(c) docketing statement fails to set forth the date on which the Rule 59(e) motion was filed. Appellant, too, must provide this information. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that appellant file a complete statement of jurisdiction that includes the omitted information. The statement is due on or before August 11, 2016.
