SUPPLEMENTAL MOTION IN RESPONSE TO MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT

NOW COME the defendants, by and through their undersigned counsel, and respond to Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Complaint as follows:

1. On September 3, 2015, Plaintiff Sabina Burton filed a Motion for Leave to File Supplemental Complaint and an accompanying Brief. (Dkt. Nos. 22, 23.) The proposed supplemental pleading adds one hundred paragraphs containing allegations since the time of the filing of the Amended Complaint (Dkt. No. 10) and adds an additional defendant.
2. In addition to the information provided in Defendants' original response (Dkt. No. 24), Defendants' counsel wish to make clear that they do not oppose the plaintiff's motion. Defendants' counsel believe that adjudicating both sets of allegations together will serve the interests of judicial economy and best conserve the parties' resources.

3. However, in order to proceed efficiently and effectively in light of the new allegations, the parties will require additional time for pretrial discovery and motion practice that is not contemplated by the current schedule.
4. Defendants therefore request that this Court vacate the current dispositive motion deadline of September 16, 2015 and set the matter for a scheduling conference at the Court's convenience to set a new schedule, including a time by which the Defendants shall file an answer or otherwise respond to the proposed supplemental complaint. (Dkt. No. 24 - Motion to Amend Briefing Schedule.)
