Dr. Dalecki,

I have requested repeatedly that you assign me to teach CJ/FI seminar. I am now the most senior faculty member in the CJ program for on campus teaching and you will not be in the department next fall. However, you assigned seminar to a probationary faculty member, Dr. Nemmetz, who was hired in 2014. What are the reasons you decided to reject my request?

You assigned the "CJ Patterns" class to me, a course I have never taught for UW-Platteville. This course was previously taught by Dr. Nemmetz. Why didn't you assign Dr. Nemmetz to teach this 3000 level course and assign me to teach the 4000 level seminar course? Dr. Nemmetz could teach "Women & the Law." I am a tenured associate professor and should have priority over a probationary second year assistant professor. Please assign seminar to me. This would acknowledge my seniority in the department, a seniority that I have earned.

You did not consult me on the name of the Current Topics Course, "Hacking, Stalking, Bullying and ID Theft," that you assigned me to teach. I did not like the title you gave the course last year and I still do not like it. Several students have objected to the name of the course. The wording does not sound very professional on a transcript that students use to apply for jobs on federal and state level. You do not have a background in CJ and should defer to my expertise in this matter. I should have been given opportunity to name the course. I request that the name of the course be changed to "Cyberforensic Investigation," which better reflects the subject matter. The course should be cross-listed as a current topics course for CJ and FI majors.

I request that you please do not assign Current Topics courses to me without consulting me first.
