I know you were trying to help me but your revelation that Dalecki and Throop discussed my termination really stressed me. I apologized for my harsh tone in the email but not for the true content. I think, considering the injustice I have been suffering since the student sexual harassment complaint, I deserve at least the same benefit of the doubt as do Caywood, Johnson, Reed, and Cecil.

Although the HR director told me not to fear termination I do not feel safe. Whistle-blowers are always bullied.

I am emailing you as you represent Dalecki in his absence. I saw a doctor yesterday and another today. They are treating me for severe tension headaches and migraines. I will get letters from both doctors indicating that I shouldn't be driving much. This will of course impact my internship visits. Unless my husband can drive me I won't be able to visit with my interns in Oshkosh, Milwaukee and other cities. I don't want anyone to misinterpret this as insubordination so I will email you the letter(s) as soon as I get them.

Please let me know if there is an issue with me doing the

internship/department visits by Skype or phone instead. I have been in constant contact with my interns and provided feedback to all of their report packages.
