Per Daleck's request, a verbal warning was issued to cease and desist.

01/31/2014 10:33 Officer Knoernschild left a voice message for Caywood.

01/31/2014 12:08 Caywood spoke with Officer Knoernschild. She indicated that she did have some words with Dalecki. She indicated that she would stay away from Dalecki if he stays away from her. She stated that Dalecki walked out of the library looking at her "like some sort of pervert." She was advised further action could lead to citations. It should be noted that there are underlying issues between Caywood's husband and Dalecki occurring at their workplace on campus. Caywood was requesting that Officer Knoernschild contact the provost to make these issues stop. Caywood was advised that those issues could not be dealt with by the police and she should contact a lawyer if need be.
