REVIEW:

What is the intellectual merit of the proposed activity?

The project proposes to develop a multi-disciplinary curriculum on cyber security and cyber assurance, establish partnerships within businesses and government agencies. The solicitation contained very little detail on how to do so, a major concern to the reader.

What are the broader impacts of the proposed activity?

Dissemination strategy seems lacking and very vague. This solicitation needs specifics of how exactly any of the broader impacts listed will be achieved. Proposers list processes such as the act of curriculum development on emerging trends and issues in government, businesses and education but don't lay out what those trends are. Almost every point addressed in broader impacts follows this path.

Summary Statement

A poorly written proposal with little to no detail. The prospers make

sweeping statements but do not give specifics from what the reader could ascertain.
