In addition, the panel agreed that the PIs need to articulate learning outcomes and state how those goals will be assessed.

The panel agreed that the proposal presents a good management plan and time line.

Broader Impacts:

The panel agreed that the proposal should provide more details on how the results of the curriculum development will be disseminated.

The panel liked the goal of reaching out to underrepresented groups. However, the plans for how this will be done should be more clearly stated.
