Would you kindly provide me by reply email a copy of the exhibits that have been marked at the hearing to date?

I don't have subpoena power, of course, in a matter like this. So, would you also please arrange for Dr. Shields to appear, as well as Dr. Throop, Dr. Strobl, Dr. Banachowski-Fuller, and Dr. Solar? I would like to conduct a short cross-examination of each. I think it is important for the panel to hear and see these witnesses, and so, I would object to telephone testimony. But that is a decision for the panel, of course.

The transcript of the March hearing seems to suggest that you rested your case. But could you please confirm that you are not calling further witnesses?

I will have my remaining witness list for you by the end of the day.

Finally, there does not seem to be any way that I can see to complete the testimony in the time allotted next week. Kindly let me know what your position is regarding timing. I think we could wrap up in another session, with about another half day to present, with brief closings. Hopefully, you and the panel agree that we can avoid post-hearing written submissions.
